The project will deploy a comprehensive Middle Mile network that will expand broadband service for emergency responders utilizing LTE technology and offer wireless broadband service to community anchor institutions and residential and business end users.

As the largest city in the BayWEB region and one of the three Bay Area cities to petition the original FCC 700 MHz waiver, the City of San Jose joins with many other regional partners that have significant questions regarding the grant application and the proposed implementation that need to be answered to ensure a successful project. This project will directly impact our community's safety and security, along with that of the ten Bay Area counties and more than 100 Bay Area cities.
