**RE: San Francisco Bay Area Urban Area Petition for a Waiver of Deadline to  
Submit Lease Administrative Fee.**

The San Francisco Bay Area Urban Area submits a request for waiver of the deadline to pay a lease administrative fee to the Public Safety Spectrum Trust (PSST), as required due to an internal Auditor/Controller Issue with the Fiscal Agent responsible for ensuring payment.

Under Section 1.925 of the Commission's rules, that Commission may grant such a waiver if a petitioner demonstrates:

1. The underlying purpose of the rule(s) would not be served or would be frustrated by application to the instant case and that a grant of the requested waiver would be in the public interest.

We seek the waiver of the rule(s) so that payment of the PSST lease administrative fee may be made within 30 Days of November 1 (i.e., by December 1, 2010), due to the need to resolve outstanding administrative issues with the Auditor/Controller and have the funds appropriately allocated for payment.

For the foregoing reason, the Bay Area Urban Area respectfully requests the Bureau to grant the petition for waiver of it rule(s) and allow the Bay Area Urban Area to make the payment to PSST no later than December 1, 2010.
